





Pearl Harbor Survivor Shares with East Elementary

On Friday, January 24, students at East Elementary were able to listen to James Downing, a Pearl Harbor survivor assigned to the USS West Virginia, talk about his experiences on that fateful day. Mr. Downing turned 100 years old last August, and is the oldest survivor of the December 7, 1941 attack. After his remarks, Mr. Downing took questions from the student audience. The depth of the questions posed would make all at TCA proud. As a history teacher myself, I count this as one of those rare opportunities to be able to interact with those that have been involved in a critical juncture of our history. A hearty thanks goes out to Mr. Downing for taking the time to share with the students at TCA, and for Dr. Coulter, TCA's Executive Director, and Amy Nelson, our East Elementary Principal for arranging this special opportunity.

We value the wisdom and life experience of the senior citizens in our community.





presented at Oxford in 1947



written in 1865, published in 1867




When the proofs, the figures, were ranged in columns before me, When I was shown the charts and the diagrams, to add, divide, and measure them,
