Choir lettering requirements are weighted by grade because as students reach higher grade levels we expect a higher level of maturity, knowledge, and participation, as well as an increase in the expressions of character traits such as attitude and service.

For example, preparedness for a concert at an underclassman level requires classroom participation, whereas preparedness as an upperclassman frequently requires taking ownership of a piece and practicing additional hours; taking ownership with event set-up as an underclassman means being present and willing to work and be trained, whereas as an upperclassman it means knowing the process, participating, and training underclassmen

10 points are required to letter. Each additional 10 points will result in a bar. **Letters are awarded in September of the following school year,** except for senior year when they are awarded prior to graduation.
