Multiplication Game - Around the World

Play this in a family room or living room where there are many pieces of furniture. The child stands on one piece of furniture. The parent shows them a flash card. The child has 2 seconds to answer the problem. If they are correct, they “fly” to the next piece of furniture. They continue going “around the world” with correct answers until they are back where they started. You can continue to circle the “world” as many times as you like. If the child does not answer correctly, a piece of the plane falls off. After ___ number of pieces of the plane have fallen off, the plane crashes and the game is over. (You set the number of pieces before the game is over — usually 3-5.)
