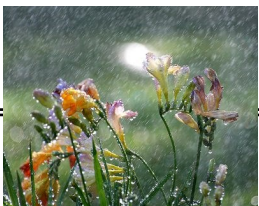

CMAS Testing This Week

The third graders will be doing the Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS) on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday this week. The students will be taking an English Language Arts test in the morning **from 8:30-10:15** and a Math test in the afternoon **from 1:35-2:55**. Please do not schedule any appointments during this time. In addition, please help your child get to **bed** on time each night before the test and feed them a healthy, hearty **breakfast** each day. Please also make sure your child has **two healthy snacks** for between testing. There will be **no math homework Monday through Wednesday** due to testing.
