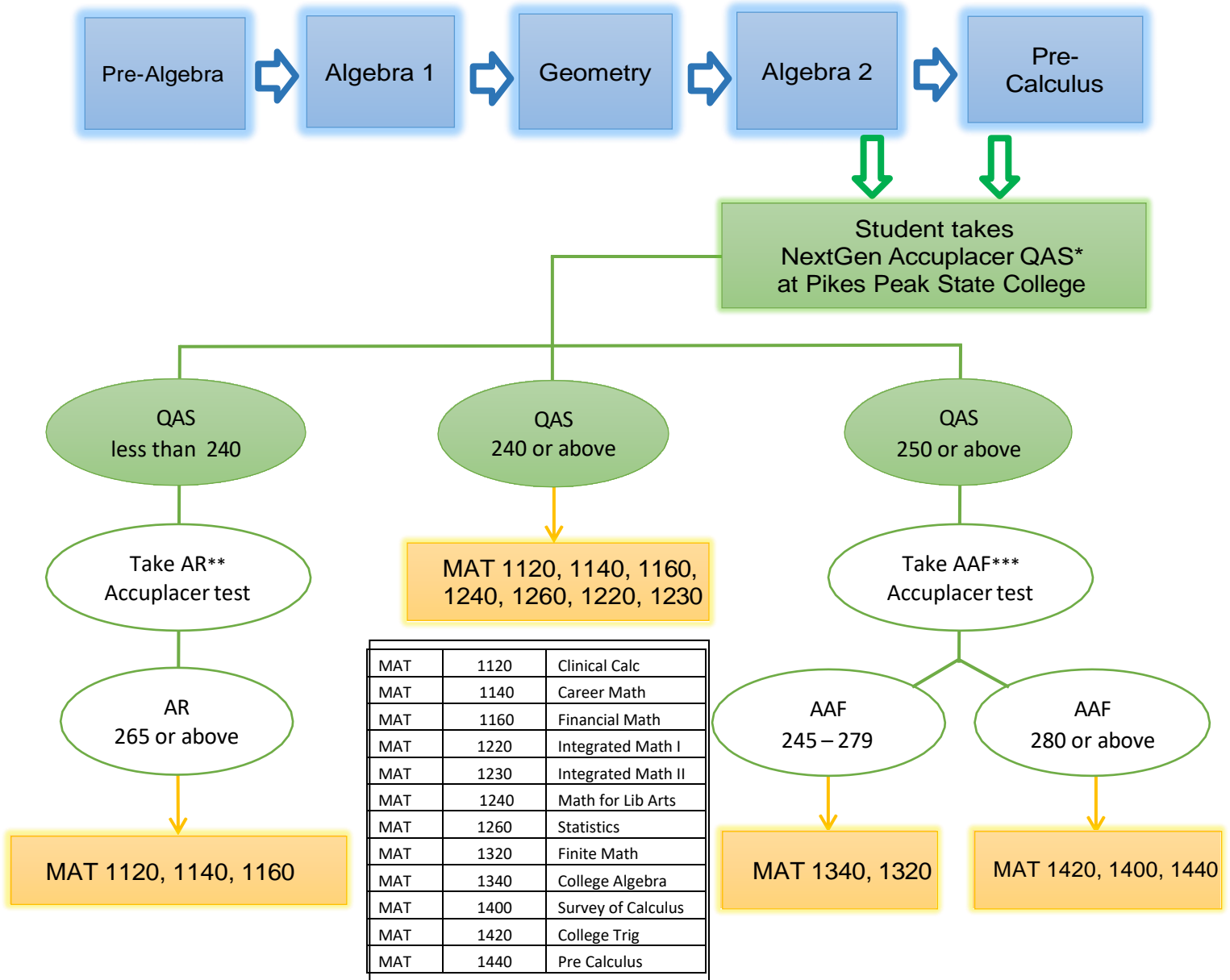


College Pathways Math Course Flowchart

COLLEGE PATHWAYS COURSES: It is recommended students earn a grade of 70% or higher to move onto the next course. Additionally, a student's test average may be considered as it is a more accurate reflection of content mastery.

PPSC MATH COURSES

- Require a final grade of D or better to receive high school credit towards graduation
- Typically D = 60 – 69.9% and C = 70 – 79.9% but please consult the course syllabus for grading percentages

College Pathway Graduation Requirements:

- Six math credits must be earned in high school:
 - one semester in high school = one unit of credit
 - one semester in college = two units of credit
- Must include Algebra 1 and Geometry either in middle school or in high school
