TCA GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

- **40 Hours:** Ten hours may be fulfilled in service to the immediate TCA community/30 hours must be completed outside the TCA community.* *Students are recommended to serve an average of 10 hours per year during grades 9-12. These 10 hours per year should be completed in the context of 3-4 distinct experiences.*
- **4 Reflection Papers**: Each paper must be typed and with a minimum of **350 words EACH** about the service experience. Recommendation: Please use "Times New Roman size 12 font" and double space. **Include word count on paper**.

Note: Titan time annual community service day will not count toward CS hours.

Reflection Paper Topics may include, but are not limited to:

What did I learn from this experience?
What did I like (or not like) about this service project?
Would I serve for this same cause again?
What impact did I make on another person?
What were the character traits most exemplified in this experience?
