State Assessment Schedule (Grades 7-11) and Exemption Deadline

Specific grade-level emails have been sent to all TCA secondary families (7-11).

Schedule: As part of the Colorado School Day assessment in partnership with CollegeBoard, the PSAT9, PSAT10, and SAT (now in digital format) will be administered on school-managed devices.

• Due to limited devices at TCA, we will be administering these tests over the course of two days for 9th, two days for 10th, and 1 day for 11th graders.

- The CMAS (7,8, and 11th grade) will still be a paper-based test and administered in 6 mornings for 7th, 9 mornings for 8th, and 1 day for 11th graders.

Exemption: In accordance with the policy <u>IKA-R-TCA</u>, the parent/guardian of a student enrolled at TCA may request that his or her child be exempt from participating in one or more state assessments. **To meet state registration deadlines for planning purposes, it is necessary for families to complete the online exemption form/survey <u>Secondary Exemption Form</u> (link) by Friday, March 15, 2024. D20 Choice Information

Each year, D20 offers choice enrollment opportunities beginning in January for the upcoming school year. TCA is not a D20 choice option. We are a waitlist school and currently enrolled students automatically move on to the next grade level each year.
