State Assessment Schedule

Student Data Consent Forms (<u>HERE</u>) have been distributed to **10-11th grade students** and are **due in the front office by this Friday, March 8** only if:

• you consent that your child shares additional information to access their scores and more in the <u>BigFuture School</u> mobile app.

Exemption: Policy <u>IKA-R-TCA</u> states that the parent/guardian may request that their child be exempt from participating in one or more state assessments.

• Online exemption form/survey <u>Secondary Exemption Form</u> (link) is due by Friday, March 15, 2024.

Schedule: The PSAT9, PSAT10, and SAT (now in digital format) will be administered on school-managed devices.

- Due to limited devices at TCA, we will be administering these tests over the course of two days for 9th, two days for 10th, and 1 day for 11th graders.
- The CMAS (7,8, and 11th grade) will still be a paper-based test and administered in 6 mornings for 7th, 9 mornings for 8th, and 1 day for 11th graders.
