## State Assessment Schedule

Student Data Consent Forms (HERE) have been distributed to 10-11 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ grade students and are due in the front office by this Friday, March 8 only if:

- you consent that your child shares additional information to access their scores and more in the BigFuture School mobile app.
Exemption: Policy IKA-R-TCA states that the parent/guardian may request that their child be exempt from participating in one or more state assessments.
- Online exemption form/survey Secondary Exemption Form (link) is due by Friday, March 15, 2024.
Schedule: The PSAT9, PSAT10, and SAT (now in digital format) will be administered on school-managed devices.
- Due to limited devices at TCA, we will be administering these tests over the course of two days for $9^{\text {th }}$, two days for $10^{\text {th }}$, and 1 day for $11^{\text {th }}$ graders.
- The CMAS ( 7,8 , and $11^{\text {th }}$ grade) will still be a paper-based test and administered in 6 mornings for $7^{\text {th }}, 9$ mornings for $8^{\text {th }}$, and 1 day for $11^{\text {th }}$ graders.
