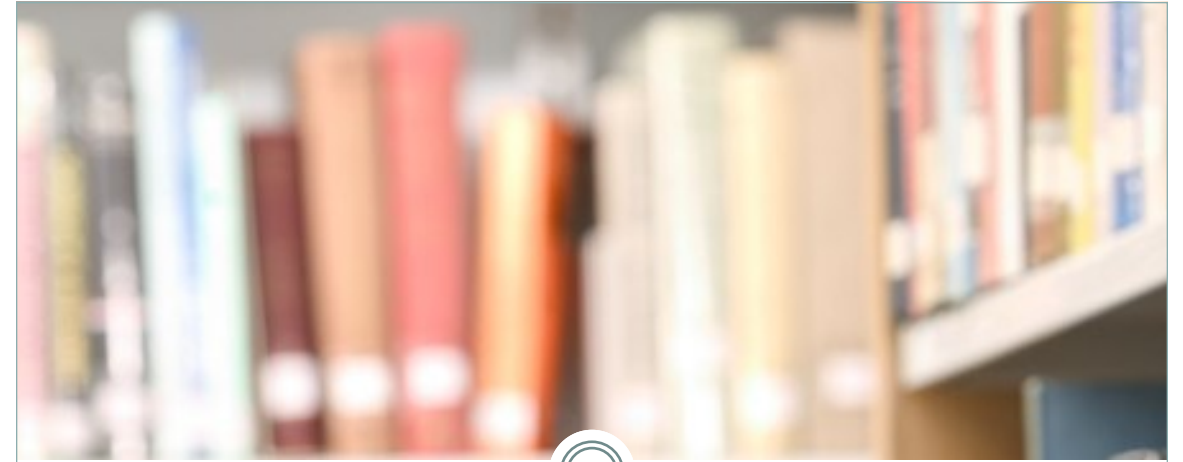
CHARACTER FOCUS FOR THE YEAR:
