Welcome to Grade 3 Cottage School!

The following must fit in your child's pencil box or a pencil bag (Please send these on the first day): 2 dry erase markers (thin) 1 plastic pencil box or pencil bag (do not choose a big one) 1 white rubber eraser 1 Crayola 24-count box of sharpened, wooden colored pencils (please take these out of the box and put them in the pencil box/bag) 1 small pair metal scissors (Fiskars) 1 small glue stick
These should be labeled with your child's name (Please send these on the first day): 1 plastic blue folder, with pockets, no brads, labeled on front with student name and "Take Home" title 1 green plastic folder with 3 prongs and pockets labeled with student's name on the front 1 durable 3-ring binder with pockets; 1 inch 5 tabbed dividers with pockets for the binder (Before the first day, please label "IEW (writing), Vocabulary, Grammar, Literature, and Roots-up") Backpack with a pocket for a water bottle (large enough to hold all supplies and your child's name on it) Water bottle with a secure lid (no glass please)
Community Supplies (to be brought at Meet and Greet): Boys 1 packet of wide-ruled reinforced loose leaf notebook paper 1 box of Kleenex or paper towels Girls 1 box of wet wipes (unscented – diaper wipes, NOT Clorox type wipes) 1 box of sandwich size or gallon size baggies (not the kind with a slider to close)
MUSIC Supplies: One green two-pocket folder (plastic is ideal as this will follow students each year)
PE Supplies Must wear athletic sneakers (or bring some inside the backpack on every PE day)
ART Supplies (these can be brought at Meet and Greet) 1 over-sized t-shirt – Use a sharpie marker to write, using large print, your student's full name on the front and back – this shirt will follow them year to year. 1 package of unscented baby wipes Girls: 1 box quart sized Ziploc bags Boys: 1 roll of paper towels
<u>LUNCHROOM</u> : 1 BOX of UNSCENTED wet wipes (label "lunchroom" – 100 count (baby wipes, NO Clorox type wipes)
