- Teacher's Lounge Committee (Help maintain the teacher's lounge, 5-10min a week)
- Decorations Committee (Decorate the school for various seasons/holidays)
- Yearbook Committee (Help produce the school yearbook.: pictures, collage pages, work from home)
- Take pictures at events and send to yearbook
- Staff Appreciation Week (many opportunities to participate: planning, food prep or donation, gift card donation for teachers/staff, set-up, clean-up, serve during lunch. This is another great way to get to know the staff.)
- Teacher and staff blessings (All year long. See Favorites Lists for ideas. Does not need to cost a lot of money, ie: a simple note of thanksgiving is a blessing!)
- Attend PTO meetings
- Be an active member of PTO (ie: event planning/participation, serving on the PTO Board, invite others)

- Attend School Accountability Committee (SAC) Meetings (Adopts/monitors the School Improvement Plan, serves as a focal point for input from school stakeholders and provides recommendations and advice regarding school priorities in the areas of school expenditures, school safety and academic performance)
- Attend School Board meetings. Be informed.
- Sign-up to receive PTO emails to stay informed
- Read weekly newsletters (school and grade level)

- Bring in unwanted uniforms, and donate to the front office, for students needing a change of clothes at school
